

AFSC Spring 2025 Ice Show - Costume Instructions

We are so excited to have you join us in our show this year. It's our favorite part of the year and we hope you'll agree.

This year we were fortunate to receive our costumes early, with this comes a few important reminders.

- 1) Have your skater try on their costume immediately. Please report any manufacturing errors within 1-2 days to Lisa Olson (763-234-8721, lisa@cuttingedgealex.com) so we can try to replace the costume.

- 2) Store the costumes in the garment bag somewhere where they will not be touched until pictures/show time. Most costumes will require steaming/gentle ironing prior to pictures/shows. **It is your responsibility to keep the costume in pristine condition for pictures and the show.**

- 3) In the back of the garment bag is a small zipper pouch. In there you'll find any accessories that go with the costumes, do not lose these, there are no replacements.

- 4) Pictures will be taken the evening of February 19, 2025. Specific picture times will be announced as we get closer, please make sure that your skater's hair and accessories are done according to directions.

- 5) Clean and hole free tights are required for pictures and the shows. These can be purchased from the club, we recommend having a back up pair in case of snags/runs/holes.

Snowplow Sam: Bibbidi-Bobbidi-Boo (Cinderella)



Costume: Please hang your costume and use a garment bag to cover when transporting your costume. Your skater will need their costume (bodysuit/jacket, skirt, and hat) and tights. Skaters are **NOT** allowed to have food or drink while they are in their costume.

Hair pieces (tiara) will be in the back zipper pouch of the garment bag.

Pictures: Please have skaters completely ready before coming to pictures as changing space is very limited. Skates should be on your skater along with **hard guards**. Please have hair done according to instructions.

Hair: Skaters should wear their hair in a medium high bun (as pictured).

Make-up: It is important for pictures and the shows, that your skater wears make-up otherwise their beautiful faces look very washed out by the bright lights. If preferred, skaters should wear a rose-pink blush on their cheeks, light brown eyeshadow, red-brown neutral lipstick, and mascara. No nail polish.

Jewelry: There is no jewelry allowed in pictures or the show. Clear crystal small studded earrings will be allowed.

Basic 1-3: When Will My Life Begin (Tangled)



Costume: Please hang your costume and use a garment bag to cover when transporting your costume. Girl skaters will need their costume, tights, and ponytail cuff. Skaters are **NOT** allowed to have food or drink while they are in their costume.

Hair pieces (rhinestone hair slide) will be in the back zipper pouch of the garment bag.

Pictures: Please have skaters completely ready before coming to pictures as changing space is very limited. Skates should be on your skater along with **hard guards**. Please have hair done according to instructions.

Hair: Hair should be in a braided low pony with the hairpiece clipped next to the hair tie on the right side of the head.

*****It is very important to keep track of this hair piece as there are no replacements*****

Make-up: It is important for pictures and the shows, that your skater wears make-up otherwise their beautiful faces look very washed out by the bright lights. Skaters should wear a rose-pink blush on their cheeks, light brown eyeshadow, red-brown neutral lipstick, and mascara. No nail polish.

Jewelry: There is no jewelry allowed in pictures or the show. Clear crystal small studded earrings will be allowed.

Basic 4-6: We Own The Night (Zombies)



Costume: Please hang your costume and use a garment bag to cover when transporting your costume. Skaters will need their costume, tights, and hair piece. Skaters are **NOT** allowed to have food or drink while they are in their costume.

Hair pieces (fabric for ponytail, wolf ears will be distributed closer to pictures) will be in the back zipper pouch of the garment bag.

Pictures: Please have skaters completely ready before coming to Photo Magic as changing space is very limited. Skates should be on your skater along with **hard guards**. Please have hair done according to instructions.

Hair: Skaters should wear their hair in a high pony with the fabric tied around it.

*****It is very important to keep track of this hair piece as there are no replacements*****

Make-up: It is important for pictures and the shows, that your skater wears make-up otherwise their beautiful faces look very washed out by the bright lights. Skaters should wear a rose-pink blush on their cheeks, light brown eyeshadow, red-brown neutral lipstick, and mascara. No nail polish.

Jewelry: There is no jewelry allowed in pictures or the show. Clear crystal small studded earrings will be allowed.

Costume: Please hang your costume and use a garment bag to cover when transporting your costume. Skaters will need their costume, tights, and hair piece. Skaters are **NOT** allowed to have food or drink while they are in their costume.

Hair pieces (crown/tiara) and choker will be in the back zipper pouch of the garment bag.

Pictures: Please have skaters completely ready before coming to Photo Magic as changing space is very limited. Skates should be on your skater along with **hard guards**. Have hair done according to instructions.

Hair: Skaters should wear their hair in a high pony bubble braid with the crown placed in front as pictured.

*****It is very important to keep track of this hair piece as there are no replacements*****

Make-up: It is important for pictures and the shows, that your skater wears make-up otherwise their beautiful faces look very washed out by the bright lights. Skaters should wear a rose-pink blush on their cheeks, light brown eyeshadow, red-brown neutral lipstick, and mascara. No nail polish.

Jewelry: There is no jewelry allowed in pictures or the show. Clear crystal small studded earrings will be allowed.

Costume: Please hang your costume and use a garment bag to cover when transporting your costume. Skaters will need their costume (dress, gloves, and hair barrette) and tights. Skaters are **NOT** allowed to have food or drink while they are in their costume.

Hair pieces (jeweled bun wrap) and wrist cuffs will be in the back zipper pouch of the garment bag.

Pictures: Please have skaters completely ready before coming to Photo Magic as changing space is very limited. Skates should be on your skater along with **hard guards**. Have hair done according to instructions.

Hair: Skaters should wear their hair in a high ponytail with hair wrap at base (as pictured).

*****It is very important to keep track of hair piece and gloves as there are no replacements*****

Make-up: It is important for pictures and the shows, that your skater wears make-up otherwise their beautiful faces look very washed out by the bright lights. Skaters should wear a rose-pink blush on their cheeks, light brown eyeshadow, red-brown neutral lipstick, and mascara. No nail polish.

Jewelry: There is no jewelry allowed in pictures or the show. Clear crystal small studded earrings will be allowed.

Hair pieces (clip, applique, fascinator (tbd if using)) will be in the back zipper pouch of the garment bag.

Pictures: Please have skaters completely ready before coming to Photo Magic as changing space is very limited. Skates should be on your skater along with **hard guards**. Have hair done according to instructions.

Hair: Skaters should wear their hair in a low bun, hair piece on the right side..

Make-up: It is important for pictures and the shows, that your skater wears make-up otherwise their beautiful faces look very washed out by the bright lights. Skaters should wear a rose-pink blush on their cheeks, light brown eyeshadow, red-brown neutral lipstick, and mascara. No nail polish.

Jewelry: There is no jewelry allowed in pictures or the show. Clear crystal small studded earrings will be allowed.
